The Medical man who contracts for the latter must engage to reside at Llanfihangel y Croyddin, or within three miles of it. Proposals, addressed to the Board of Guardians, must be sent to the Clerk of the Union, on or before Thursday, the 5th of April, accompanied with testimonials as to professional skill, qualification, and moral conduct. The appointment will take place on Friday, the 13th of April. The Clerk will give any further information that may be required.
