## Medal Index Cards

- 10,000 sheets of microfiche in the series WO 372 each sheet containing 360 separate index cards for 5.5 million soldiers
- Created by the Army Medal Office and arranged by surname
- Available to search and download on Documents Online

- 3<sup>rd</sup> most popular download (68,000 hits since January 2009)
- Provide references to medal rolls
- Medal rolls are in the series WO 329 and produced as original documents



## Medal Index cards typically contain...

- Surname, initial(s) or forename(s)
- Rank(s)
- Regimental Number(s)
- Regiment(s) or Corp(s) served in
- Specific medals to which a man or woman was entitled to
- References to those Medal Rolls and the pages where further details were recorded
- The first theatre of war served in
- The date of entry into that theatre
- Any important remarks – eg KIA (Killed in Action)



## Medal Rolls in WO 329

- 3,273 separate Medal Rolls
- These are split into a number of different rolls for different awards –
- British War and Victory Medals
  - 1914 Star
  - 1914/15 Star
  - Territorial Force War Medal
  - Silver War Badge
- They are arranged by regiment; there are separate rolls for Officers and Other Ranks

Campaign medals were awarded to individuals who served in the First World War, who met the qualifications laid down for each medal. In general all those who saw service overseas were awarded a campaign medal. The qualifications for each campaign medal are:



### 1914 Star

Instituted in 1917 for service ashore in France and Flanders between 5 August and 22 November 1914. In 1919 a clasp bearing the above dates was authorised and given to those individuals who had actually been under fire between the prescribed dates.



### 1914/15 Star

Authorised in 1918, the 1914/15 Star was awarded to those individuals who saw service in France and Flanders from 23 November 1914 to 31 December 1915, and to those individuals who saw service in any other operational theatre from 5 August 1914 to 31 December 1915.



### British War Medal

The British War Medal 1914-1920, authorised in 1919, was awarded to eligible service personnel and civilians. Qualification for the award varied slightly according to service. The basic requirement for army personnel and civilians was that they either entered a theatre of war, or rendered approved service overseas between 5 August 1914 and 11 November 1918. Service in Russia in 1919 and 1920 also qualified for the award.



### Victory Medal

The Victory Medal 1914-1919 was also authorised in 1919 and was awarded to all eligible personnel who served on the establishment of a unit in an operational theatre.



## Medal Rolls may contain.....

- Battalion numbers or unit of regiments served in. This will enable researchers to then track down a specific war diary for that battalion
- Details of who the medals were actually issued to
- Full lists of all men or women serving in a given battalion or unit
- The Silver War Badge lists tell you:
  - When an individual joined the Army
  - When they were discharged
  - Why they were discharged – sickness or wounds
  - Ages of individuals

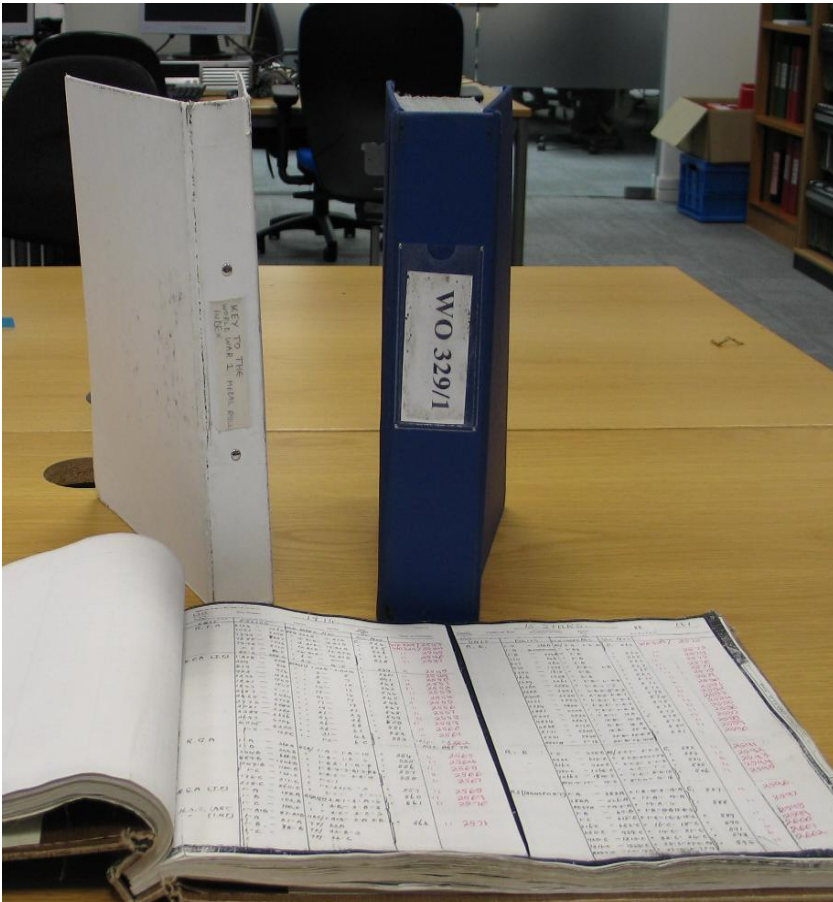

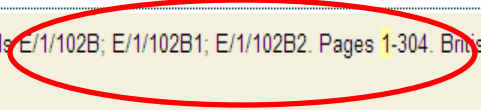

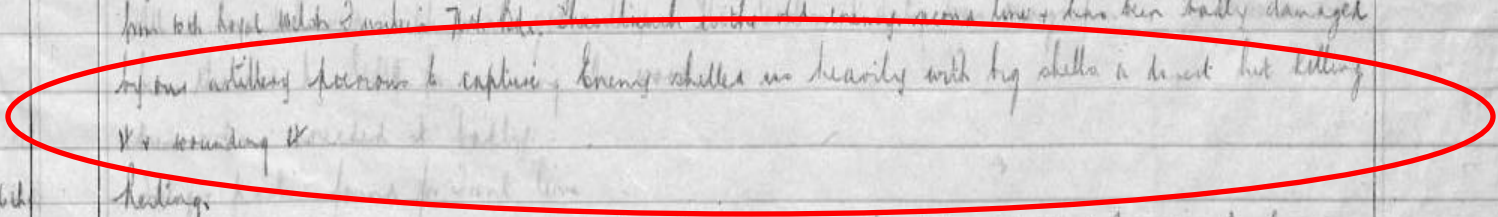

We moved off via Montambert - Bligny - Bothe Wood to Belleville. A fierce artillery bombardment was going on all the way up. We reinforced the 1st RRL Corps on the right of the Wood. Enemy gave no answer.
