Search No. 1. Passengers traveling from UK ports to New England, Barbados and other colonies, 1634-1639 and 1677

Catalogue reference: E 157

This source is printed and may be available in other libraries and archives.

Information that this source should reveal:

These registers have been printed in Hotten's *Original Lists of Persons Emigrating to America 1600-1700*, Coldham's *Complete Book of Emigrants* and Filby's *Passenger and Immigration Lists Index*

---

Factors affecting success of a search:

Some of the original documents are not in a very good condition and are difficult to read. There is no guarantee that the information will be found. Therefore it is better to consult the printed sources.

Search No. 2. Privy Council and related bodies: America and West Indies, Colonial Papers (General Series), 1574-1688

Catalogue reference: CO 1

These registers have been printed in Hotten's *Original Lists of Persons Emigrating to America 1600-1700* and Coldham's *Complete Book of Emigrants*.

Information that this source should reveal:

A list of passengers, on board vessels bound for America. It gives the names of passengers and their ages.

Search No. 3.        Treasury Register, 1773-1776

Catalogue references: T 47/9-12

---

Information that this source should reveal:

Port customs officials kept this register of emigrants going from England, Wales and Scotland to the New World. It gives an account of all persons who have taken their passage from any port in mainland Britain with a description of their age; name of the ship; occupation; former residence; which port or place they propose to go to; the reason they are leaving the country and master's name.

Search No. 4.        New Zealand Company Original Correspondence, 1839-1850

Catalogue references: CO 208/269-272 and CO 208/273-274

---

Information that this source should reveal:

This is a register of cabin passengers who emigrated between 1839 and 1850. It gives the name of the cabin passengers; age; name of the port from which they sailed; date; occupation and intended destination. CO 208/273-274 contains applications for free passage.

Factors affecting success of a search:

Details required to carry out a search, and our Charge for a search:  
It is essential that the name of the ship be provided. If this, together with all the other information marked with an asterisk\*, is provided then the standard charge of £60 will apply.

Search No. 5.            Passenger Lists of H.M. Steam Packets, 1831-1834

Catalogue reference: ADM 30/35

---

Information that this source should reveal:

These are lists of passengers carried on H.M. steam packets to, from and within the Mediterranean area. It gives; name date of embarkation; date and place of disembarkation; name of the vessel and name of the commander. The document is arranged by ship's name.

Factors affecting success of a search:

If the name of the ship is unknown, a search will be lengthy and may be unsuccessful.

Details required to carry out a search, and our Charge for a search:

If the name of the ship is provided, together with all the other information marked with an asterisk\*, then the standard charge of £60 will apply.

Search No. 6.            Exchequer: Kings Remembrancer: Port Books, 1565-1799

Catalogue reference: E 190

---

Information that this source should reveal:

The series is arranged by port of departure. Usually names, port of departure and port of arrival are given together with date of departure.

Factors affecting success of a search:

A typescript index for those emigrating to America, 1618-1668 is available at The National Archives.
