The 'ringleaders' were transferred to Parkhurst, and those acquitted were transferred to various prisons far away from their homes. Also includes parliamentary questions requesting that review of the prison sentences which had been awarded , on the grounds that they unnecessarily harsh, and photographs of the prison after the mutiny.

Details of an incident at the prison involving approximately one hundred and fifty prisoners, during which the administrative block was destroyed by fire. Includes an official report on the mutiny, extensive newspaper coverage, verbatim reports provided by prison officers and convicts to the enquiry chaired by Mr Herbert du Parcq KC and details of services rendered by St John's ambulance staff to prison officers and inmates who were injured. Also included is a report of a telephone conversation with the Governor on the night before the mutiny occurred.
