Records review panel

10 September 2007

Gift of non-public records relating to the British Shipbuilders Corporation

The Panel agreed to the recommendations in the paper, saying that these records from July 1985 to date should come to The National Archives as a gift, on the understanding that any copyright and sensitivity review issues would be clarified with the holding department, the Department for Business, Enterprise and Regulatory Reform (BERR). The records from 1977 – 1985 were currently being sought by BERR.

Customs and Excise Service Registers

The Client Manager for Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs (HMRC) gave an update on the presentation of these records, after The National Archives had decided in April 2005 to approach the Society of Genealogists as a possible repository with HMRC's agreement. The Panel sanctioned the ongoing negotiations with HMRC concerning statute bars.
