

Self-assessment Panel

2 December 2008

Meeting summary

The Panel met to review the 2008 self-assessment and moderate the scores. Each score was considered and adjustments made where necessary. Scores for services in Wales relating questions 36-38 were reviewed to ensure consistency. Each service was also ascribed one of the following 'direction of travel' statements: likely to improve further, neither improving nor deteriorating, likely to deteriorate. The Panel considered the views of services on the frequency of self-assessment and agreed that it should occur every two years.
