Arranged by station and division giving numbers of staff employed for specific roles and daily volumes of traffic. 32 large single images. No named individuals.</p> <p>RAIL 397/8 Drivers, Firemen and Motormen Timebook April 1923-March 1929 Aranged by Station and Date. Date, Train, Engine, Driver Name, On Duty/Off Duty, Fireman Name, On Duty/Off Duty. Approx. 400 single page images with an average of 47 names per single image. Many Names duplicated.</p> <p>RAIL 397/13 Staff Histories Stratford Works 1914-1963 Name, Date of Birth, Date Entered Service, Depot, Grade, Rate, War Wage, Remarks. Some details of Character and Disciplinary Record. Approx. 220 Single page images with 2 single images per individual record.</p>
Physical Format and Condition	Original records of bound/tagged, printed/typed pages of foolscap, A3 up to A2 size, with many dog-eared edges sometimes losing printed detail/handwritten information. Some bound volumes have loose leaf pages as they have lost their binding.
Popularity	Between 1st July 2008 and 1 st July 2009 this series of records was requested in
