ASK YOURSELF:

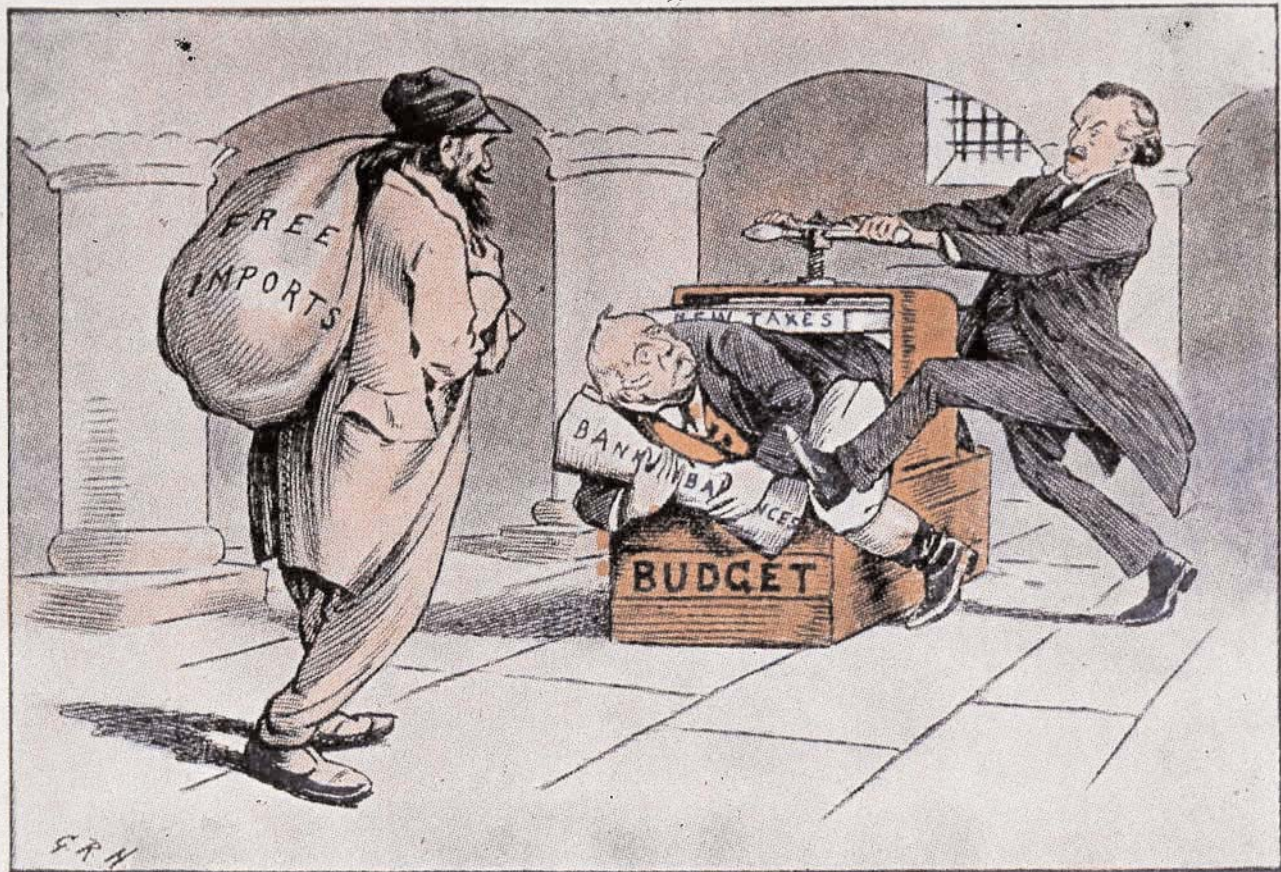
- Why has the cartoonist shown Lloyd George as having foreign friends?
