The key question in this gallery is: **How should we remember the British Empire?**

In order to tackle this question you need to study a wide range of sources.

- ⚙ Case study 1 provides sources that show how the British saw their empire in the early 20th century.
- ⚙ Case studies 2-6 provide sources about the empire from the late 1700s to the early 20th century.
