Family Papers of John Glyn Jones, Glyn Derw, Bodwrog. This extensive family collection includes papers of the Elias family, Plas y Glyn, Llanfwrog; Glyn Bodafon and Llanrwst.

Also with this collection were copies of Drysorfa, Eurgrawn Wesleyaidd and Llusern, Hafod a Hendre a Bryn a Dôl and 'Gweithiau Barddonol' Eben Fardd. These have been added to the searchroom bookshelves.

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As a result of the fragmentary deposit of the collection the catalogue is mixed up to WM 1534/110 and has then been arranged by subject, some topics may be covered by more than one section.
