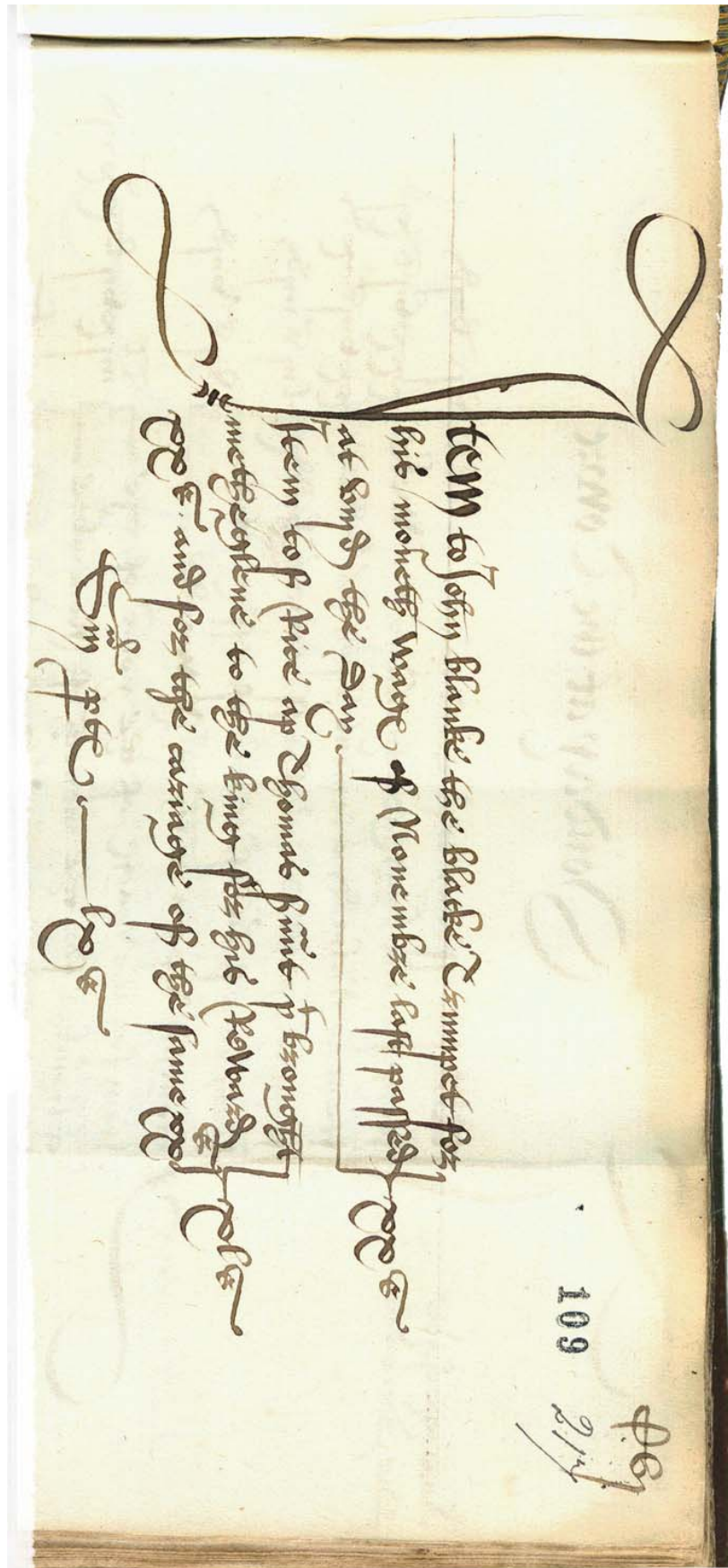
About this document

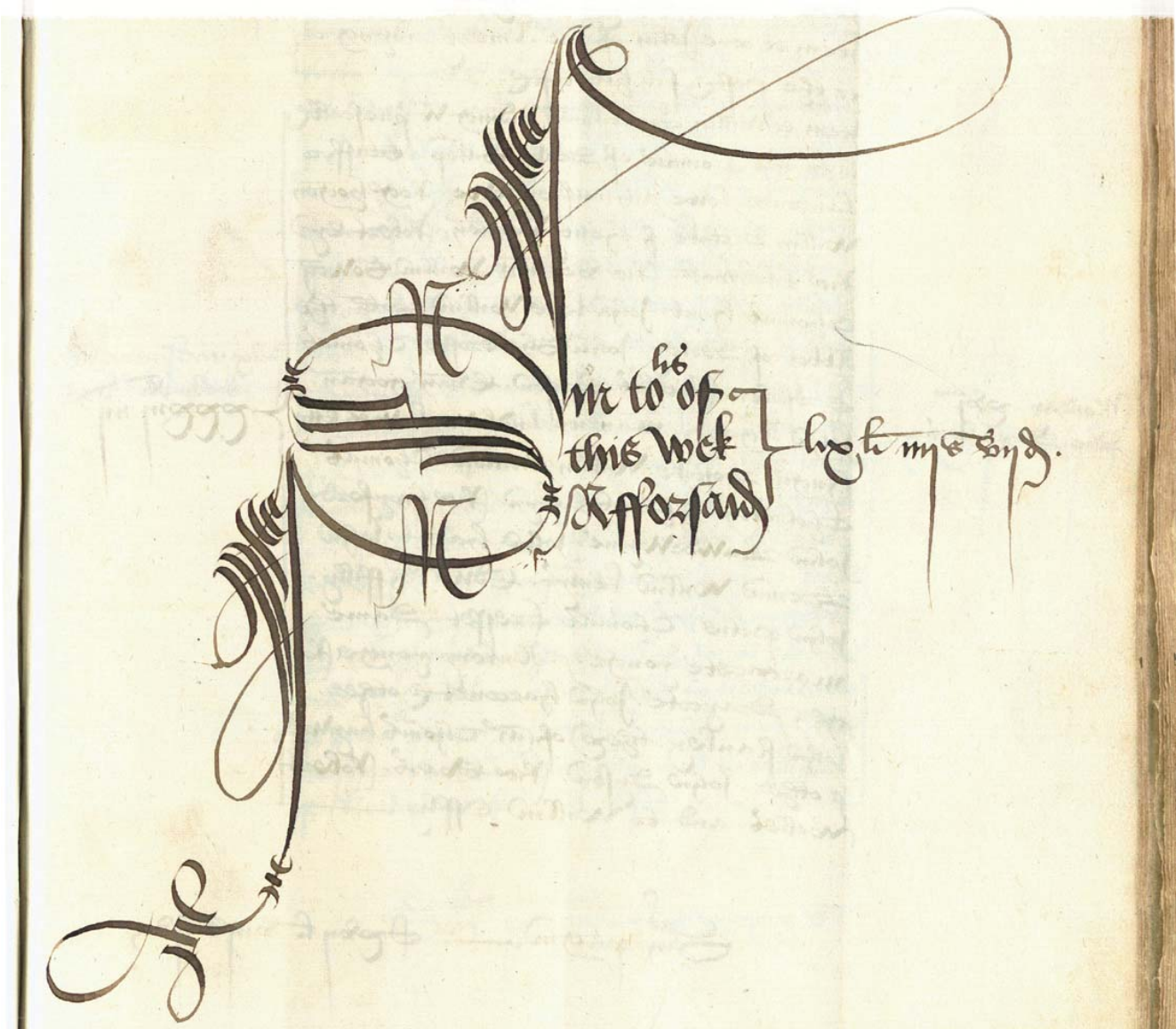
'John Blanke, the blacke trumpeter' is recorded on several occasions in the accounts of the Treasurer of the Chamber records. John Blanke was a black trumpeter, who played regularly at the courts of Henry VII and Henry VIII.

Please note:

- The document is written in a cursive secretary hand.
- The first two words in line 7, should be transcribed as S[u]m[ma] p[ar]t[ium]
- Transcribe the first two words in line 8 as S[u]m[ma] to[tal]is
