

Exercise of delegated powers conferred on the Secretary of State by the Public Records Act 1958

The Secretary of State has delegated the following powers, conferred on them by the Public Records Act 1958, to the Chief Executive and Keeper of The National Archives and his staff.

1. The giving of approval for the transfer of public records, in either direction, between The National Archives and places of deposit, as well as transfers between places of deposit is made under s. 4(3) of the Public Records Act 1958.
