Introduction

An Independent prayer meeting started in the village in 1802, with premises registered for worship in 1803. A chapel was built in 1804, and a church body was formally constituted in 1811. Deacons were apparently first appointed in 1841. There were strong links with Bucklebury (D/N 41) and Woolhampton (D/N 38) chapels; the burial of the Revd John Morton, well-known minister at Bucklebury, was recorded in the Thatcham register, which also has many baptismal entries for Bucklebury worshippers.

The church joined the United Reformed Church in 1972.
