Z2		MS. book of anthems, hymns and psalms which belonged to the Churchwardens of Fordington in 1805, and was returned there by J.S. Stroud of London in 1916. At the front, stuck in: a visiting card of Thomas Hardy, inscribed "With many thanks."	1 vol.
