Firm advertises itself as being founded in 1889 at 4 Palmerston Road. Mr Ernest J. Rands bought the business from J.B.Jackson in 1928 with his son Frederick Rands as partner. Mr E.J.Rands died in 1940 and the premises were completely bombed out in 1941. The firm therefore moved to 78 Osborne Road where it continued in business until it closed in 1970 on the death of Mr F. Rands who had always run it under the Jackson name.
