KINGSWOOD MASONIC LODGE No.2278

[The Kingswood Lodge was constituted under a warrant dated 25 August, 1888 and consecrated on 4 February 1889 at the Plough Inn, Elstree, at which time worshipful Brother Rawson Kelly was appointed first master of the Lodge. The Lodge probably took its name from the name of the private house, "Kingswood", of the head of a London firm for which a number of the original petitioners for the creation of the new Lodge worked.

Meetings of the Lodge were held at the Plough Inn, Elstree, until 1891 when the venue was transferred to the Crown Hotel, Broxbourne. In December 1916 it was decided to move the meetings to the Red Lion Hotel, Hatfield, and subsequently in 1924 a Masonic Hall containing a commodious temple and dining room was added to the hotel.

A Royal Arch Chapter of the Kingswood Lodge was consecrated in 1915. Daughter Lodges to the Kingswood Lodge are the Brookmans Park Lodge no. 7655 (consecrated 1959), the Rosewood Lodge no. 8796 (1977) and the Queens Oak Lodge no. 9262 (1988).

The first by-laws of the Lodge provided for the creation and maintenance of a Benevolent Fund supporting masonic charities. The Lodge is also a patron of the Royal Masonic Institution for Boys and vice-patron of the Royal Masonic Institution for Girls, the Royal Masonic Benevolent Institution, and the Royal Masonic Hospital.]
