## INTRODUCTION

Messrs Webb & Co Ltd., then of Avern Mills, East Molesey, Surrey, leatherdressers, began their association with Hertford in 1891 when they took a lease on the former oil cake factory at Horns Mill, Hertford. The company continued to operate from these premises until 1970 when the business was taken over by Dent Fownes Ltd who in the following year moved production to its own factories in the west of England.

The founder of Messrs Webb & Co Ltd was William Webb (d.1912). He was succeeded in the management of the company by his two sons, Frederick and Kenneth, and at the time of the sale of the business in 1970 Alan Webb (son of Frederick) had been the managing director of the company for nearly twenty years. Alan Webb was chairman of the British Leather Manufacturers' Research Association from 1968-1970.

The best known product of Messrs Webb & Co Ltd was probably the "Hertford Lammie", a luxury glove made from woolly lambs' skin.
