Henry Sykes established a small engineering business in Upper Thames Street, London, in 1857, manufacturing (for sale or hire) pumps, portable steam engines, hoists, cranes and similar equipment. In 1868 the business transferred to Bankside, Southwark, and began the construction of the deep well pumps with which Sykes' name was to become closely associated. Henry Sykes jnr. took over control of the firm in 1885 and shortly afterwards entered partnership with Edmund Jackson. For the next forty years Jackson contributed largely, not only to the firm's capital, but also to its design engineering. In 1897 Henry Sykes Ltd. was incorporated and two years' later opened a branch factory in Emerson Street, Southwark (closed in 1920). Despite the acquisition of further premises in Southwark Street and Charlton, Bankside remained the company's headquarters until 1957 when all operations were removed to Charlton.

The manufacture of pumps has been Sykes' mainstay throughout its existence, but a wide variety of other types of machinery has been produced, including cranes, steel windmills and winches for barrage balloons. The Henry Sykes Group Ltd. now comprises a diversity of engineering enterprises, active throughout the world.
