### Form of deposit

A leather-bound scrap book, 9 inches by 11 inches, containing about 450 pages to which are stuck miscellaneous correspondence and printed material

Similar correspondence and printed matter loosely interleaved in the book

A separate bundle of similar correspondence and printed matter

## Forms of reference

Each sheet bound into the book was numbered by pages as in a printed book. Occasionally sheets which had obviously been bound in were found in position, but torn away from the binding. These were paginated with the bound pages. Blank pages, though numbered, were not included in the descriptive list.

Where more than one item was stuck to or written on a page, each such item was given an alphabetical sub-number following its page reference, e.g. 22a, 22b.

Where loose items were found interleaved between bound pages, these were sub-numbered numerically according to the order in which they were found, and the sub-number placed after the preceding page number in the reference. Thus items 27/1-131 were found between pages 27 and 28.

Where more than one item was stuck to or written on a loose sheet, each such item was given an alphabetical sub-number to follow the loose sheet reference, e.g. 67/2a, 67/2b.

The separate bundle was numbered in the order found, and the letter L placed before each reference.

#### Storage

After numbering and listing, the loose interleaved material was removed from the book and bundled separately.

#### Origin

The collection appears to have been started by Thomas Crofton Croker (1798-1854), who during the later period of his life lived with his family at Rosamond's Bower, Parson's Green, Fulham, and at 3 Gloucester Road, Old Brompton. The original intention was probably to keep material relating to Croker's friends the antiquary Thomas Baylis ( -187) of The Pryor's Bank, and later Thames Bank, Fulham, and the writer and wit Theodore Edward Hook (1788-1841) latterly of Egmont Villa, Fulham. The words 'Fulham The Pryor's Bank and Egmont Villa 1837-45' are embossed on the spine of the scrap book. However, from an early date, the collection expanded to include references to other literary or antiquarian contacts. Crofton Croker's son, T.F.Dillon Croker, probably continued to collect similar letters written to him by his father's friends, and to copy letters etc. written by his father, Baylis, Hook and others into the scrap book. Owing to the fact that Dillon Croker's handwriting is almost identical to that of his father, it is difficult to determine the date or origin of some of the copied matter. Letters 27/20, 27/76 and 27/128 refer specifically to the acquisition of collections of correspondence etc. by Dillon Croker. The collection as a whole covers a period from the 1820s to the 1870s. The juxtaposition of items stuck in the book is of some significance, but the arrangement of loose material seems to bear little relation to its content except in isolated cases.
