The origins of the Com any were in France, where Monsieur Achille Serre, a dry dryer of silks at Sannois, founded a small business on the outskirts of Paris before 1870. As a result of the France - Prussian War. Monsieur Serre and his wife left for England and settled in Dalston, where Serre built a small workshop, working as a ribbon dyer and waterer. As a result of a decline in his trade he introduced the practice of 'Nettoyage a Sec' into England - borrowed from the business of a friend in France. Serre is credited with being the first dry cleaner in England. His first business premises were in a portion of Griffith's Tar Yard at Hackney Wick; subsequently he opened an office on the first floor of No 68 Cheapside in the City and a shop at No 5 queen Street, City, soon afterwards. His son Eugene took over the management of the business in 1886, bringing his brother - in - laws, W.S. and J.B.Argent into the business.

The business became a limited Company in 1906. Its factory site in Hackney Wick was rebuilt, but was too small to cope with the growth in business and two additional factories were acquired in the immediate vicinity. In 1927 the Company acquired the Walthamstow site, in the former grounds of 'Uplands', Blackhorse Lane (the house serving as a sports club and library, until World War II). The depression affected the firm badly, and portions of the Walthamstow site were sold off - all previous sites having been disposed of following the move from Hackney. The Company went into Receivership in 1939, which lasted to 1943, at which stage the Company was reconstructed and portions of the premises previously leased to the Mills Equipment Company were sold to Boake Roberts of Stratford.

In the 1950s and 1960s distant retail outlets in Glasgow, Hanchester and Scarborough were closed. Finally in 1968 the Company was taken over by Great Portlands Estates. In December 1969 the Company was sold to Sketchleys of Romford, who closed the factory in January 1970. The residue of the premises were taken over by James Hayes & Sons in Harch 1971.
