Brookfield Orthopeadic Hospital, Hale End, Walthamstow

Formerly Hale End Red Cross Hospital, otherwise Brookfild Red Cross Hospital.

This hospital began as a service organised by the Hale End District Association, which was founded as a ratepayers association c. 1909. The Red Cross Hospital was opened in 1915 in the grounds of Brookfield House, Oak Hill. It was built at the expence of Thomas Sutcliffe Armstrong, who lived at Brookfield, for the treatment of servicemen wounded in the First World War. The hospital was equiped and maintained by the Association and was run by a management committee according to the rules of the British Red Cross Society. It closed in 1919 and was subsequently used by Walthamstow Urban District Council for the reception of cases awaiting admission to the district sanitorium at Chingford. The hospital was bought by the council in 1922 and opened in the following year as a centre for the treatment of crippled children. Under the management of a committee representing local authorities in the area, Brookfield Orthopeadic Mospital did pioneer work with physically handicapped children. It was extended in 1931, but difficulty in filling the hospital led to its transfer to Essex County Council in 1936, when a hospital for 200 chronic cases was planned. The hospital closed in 1939 and was : subsequently used by Essex County Council as a Mostel for the elderly. In 1964 the Brookfield House School for Physically Handicapped Children was opened, pupils being transferred from Wingfield House School, the former Hale End Open Air School, where children from Brookfield had been transferred in 1936. The new Brookfield school was built on the site of the old hospital.
