The United Anvient Order of Druids (previously the Ancient Order of Druids) was formed in 1831. Its primary function uas to act as a friendly society. The Halthanstow Lodge 924 was formed in 1902 and met at the Brewery Tap Public House Hiarkhouse Road. A branch of 924, Lodge 868 met at the Common Gate Public Ilouse Fiarkhouse Road, until it was marged back into 924 in 1948. Lodge 924 also has an association with the Friend's Hall, Greenleaf Road.
Lodges were formed all over Jondon from the turn of the century, and, according to the denositor, at one time gave out 'national insurance cards' before the formation of the IUS in 1948.
There was also a lodge in leyton, but this was merged with the Valthamstow branch in the 1970 s and no records appear to have survived.
At the same time as this deposit was made, a number of objects were donated to the Huseum to add to an earlier gift. These include regalia, a gavel and associated items of costume.
