# Walthanstow School Board: minutes, accounts, letterbooks and other papers

## Introduction

As a result of the Education Act of 1870, Walthamstow parishioners formed a Local Committee under the ampices of the West Ham Union School Attendance Committee in 1876. This however proved unsatisfactory to the Education Department, and in 1880 a School Board was compulsorily formed. This then administered elementary schools formerly National or British schools until the Education Act of 1902 dissolved the Board and Walthamstow became a Fart III Authority for elementary education.

District Committee 2 covered Markhouse Road, Gamuel Road, South Grove, Haynard Road, Shernhall Street, Wood Street and Boundary Road schools. Both committees would appear to have been dissolved in April 1901, and April 1900 respectively.
