### Walthamstow Education Committee: Attendance and Byelaws Department

Attendance returns, records of enforcement of educational byelaws and registers of Walthamstow schools.

These records were at one time held at Lloyd Park Mansion which served as offices for the attendance officers and school medical staff from soon after its transfer to the Urban District Council. The records were moved to the Education Department's offices in the High Street (the former Monoux School buildings) and transferred to Vestry House Museum in 1980.

Attendance committees and officers were employed by the Walthamstow School Board (1880 - 1903), for records of their activities see W 58.01 M1 - 10, MS 1, MAC 1 - 3 & SM 1 - 5. Many of the admissions registers listed in section 3 below were compiled during the scool board period, but have been listed here as they appear to have been collected by the Department, which was set up initially in February 1898 and taken over by the Education Committee in May 1903.

# AD 2 Records of byelaw enforcement and truancy

For an account of the byellaws introduced by Walthamstow School Board see <u>The Walthamstow School Board 1880-1903</u> by June Dowell, Reading University MPhil thesis, 1972 pp.94 <u>et seq</u>. Early bye-laws dealt with school attendance and were supported in enforcement by incentives such as attendance medals together with sanctions such as fines on the parents of truants. This system was continued by the Education Committee after 1903, attendance at the elementary and higher elementary schools run by the Committee was required of children over 5 years of age. The department also enforced bye-laws relating to the employment of children, pursuant to the Children and Young Persons Act, 1933.

#### 3. Admissions registers (1881 - 1966)

These records were supplied to schools by the Secretary's Office of the Schoool Board / Education Committee. Once complted they appear to have been returned and kept with the records of the Attendance Department. All are in volume form, some containing loose correspondence and notes including transfer forms. Some registers have lists of teaching staff, notes concerning progress or with drawals of pupils. Most volumes are indexed at the front.
