E, HEALY THOMPSON MSS.

This collection of letters was given by a Salisbury solicitor to the Historical Association, who in turn handed it over to the Catholic Record Society in 1949. It is the correspondence of the writer Edward Healy Thompson (?1813-91), consisting of letters to him with a few drafts of his replies. He was educated at Oakham and graduated from Emmanuel College, Cambridge in 1836. For ten years he held a number of curacies, but in 1846 he and his wife (also a writer) were received into the Catholic Church. In 1853 his name was put forward as Lecturer in English Literature in Newman's new Dublin University. He died in 1891 at Cheltenham.

The letters were sorted and dated by the late Lady Cumming, who supplied the following notes.

No. 1 - This appears to be a stray from the Salisbury solicitor's office.

Nos. 2-8 - Letters to EHT. from Newman on personal, religious and literary subjects, 1841-52.

Nos. 9-30 - Correspondence between EHT. and Newman, 1853-59, when the latter was planning and then running the Catholic University in Dublin. Newman had hoped that EHT. would take the Chair of English, but when after various delays Thompson was sent for, he was ill and could not go to Dublin. The last letter explains Newman's return from Dublin.

Nos. 31-34 - Newman letters mentioning the projects that Newman should take over the editorship of the Rambler with EHT. as his sub-editor, and that EHT. should become editor of the Dublin Review in 1859.

Nos. 35-67 - These letters of 1862, largely between Manning, W. G. Ward and EHT. concern the negotiations and deliberations about the change of editorship of the <u>Dublin</u>. Wiseman had put this task in Manning's hands and ultimately Ward was appointed editor with EHT. as sub-editor. The first issue of the New Series was published in July 1863.

Nos. 71-115 - These letters, written between October 1864 and January 1865, mainly concern the bitter controversy between Ward (with Manning) on the one hand and EHT. and the Rev. Henry Coleridge, S.J., on the other after the publication of Newman's Apologia. Fr. Coleridge had been entrusted with a section in the Dublin - Our contemporaries: a review of reviews. He wished to devote the entire section in the issue of January 1865 to a defence of Newman from the attacks on the Apologia in other publications. This Ward refused to allow. Thompson strongly supported Coleridge and withdrew from the Dublin in December 1864 in protest against the injustice to Newman. These letters are almost entirely between the four protagonists, ending with a few expressing the reactions of EHT's friends to his resignation and the reasons for it.

Nos. 116-165 - Letters to EHT. mostly on literary subjects. The largest number are from Herbert Vaughan (later Cardinal), who was owner and (till 1872) editor of the <u>Tablet</u>.
