. The item P4/CO2/AMI consists of several pages of signed minutes of the Clifton Parish Council Voluntary Relief Committee and has been placed with the Clifton townships records.

This vol. contains an attached newscutting from "The Journal", 12 Oct., 1923, with a paragraph on the winding up of the Clifton Relief Fund. This states that the Fund was set up in 1914 primarily to assist the wives of absent soldiers and was later used to assist the aged poor in the parish and adds that the money was raised principally by miners.
