#### INTRODUCTION

The 1793 Higham Ferrers circuit consisted of the chapels at Bozeat, Broughton, Desborough, Hargrave, Higham Ferrers, Irchester, Isham, Kettering, Newton, Pytchley, Raunds, Ravenstone, Wellingborough and Wollaston. By 1796 the chapels at Luddington, Luffenham, Old, Rockingham, Souldrop and Walgrave had joined the circuit and Isham had left the circuit which later became the Wellingborough circuit.

In 1814-1815 the Wellingborough Wesleyan circuit included Addington, Ashby, Barton, Bozeat, Dean, Doddington, Finedon, Higham Ferrers, Irchester, Irthlingborough, Kimbolten, Raunds, Ringstead, Rushden, Stanwick, Swineshead, Sywell, Thrapston, Wellingborough, Woodford, Wollaston, Wymington and Yeldon. By 1828 this circuit had divided, and a new Higham Ferrers circuit was formed from the Wesleyan chapels of Addington, Dean, Hargrave, Higham Ferrers, Higham Park, Irthlingborough, Kimbolten, Raunds, Ringstead, Risely, Rushden, Stanwick, Swineshead, Thrapston, Tilbrook, Wymington and Yeldon.

Further additions to the circuit were: Old Weston 1830, Catworth 1833, Leighton 1834, Souldrop 1839 and Knotting Green 1843. Rushden and Wymington left the circuit in 1851.

In 1885 the circuit was again divided by the formation of the Raunds circuit. The Higham Ferrers circuit now comprised Addington Higham Ferrers, Irthlingborough, Knotting Green, Risely, Souldrop, Stanwick, Swineshead and Yeldon. In 1888, Rushden re-joined the circuit, followed by Newton in 1892.

The circuit remained unaltered, until 1933, when the Primitive Methodist church at Rushden, Fitzwilliam Street joined, leaving again in 1936. In 1945 the circuit consisted of Addington, Higham Ferrers, Irthlingborough, Knotting Green, Risely, Rushden (Park Road) Souldrop, Stanwick, Swineshead and Yeldon.

At present, 1977, the circuit consists of Higham Ferrers, Irthlingborough, Risely, Rushden (Park Road), Stanwick, Souldrop and Yeldon.
