- 20 Library Catalogue compiled about 1891 alphabetically arranged with a cross index from subjects to authors, and with some additions by C.A. Markham.
- 21 Record of subscriptions paid, alphabetically arranged 1859-1893
- Record of subscriptions paid 1863-73 with balance sheets 1862/3-1875/6.
- 23 Bank book 1863-68
- Bundle of letters about payment of subscriptions following effort to collect arrears, 1870-75, including list of those in arrear, report for 1869 with list of members marked, draft treasurer's reports or balance sheets for 1869/70, 1870/71 & 1872/3, list of receipts & expenses 1860-69, notice of the annual meeting in October, and part of a circular from Ann Dear offering reductions to the daughters of clergymen (1870). The treasurer was Rev. Henry Ward of Aldwinkle and there are a number of draft letters in reply from him and letters from Rev. H.J. Bigge of Rockingham, the librarian. The letters are from members who were mainly nobility, gentry and clergy.
- Bundle of similar letters for 1876 including draft treasurer's reports for 1873/4 & 1874/5 and a bill head of William Ibbs of Thrapston for printing circulars.
