Note: This firm whose works were in Station Road, Towcester, undertook manufacturing for A.R. Tattersall & Co. of 75 Mark Lane, London, founded in 1894. The works were established in 1854, rebuilt in 1911 and the Foundry enlarged in 1919. Another firm, The Unique Charcoal Retort Company of the same London address, also operated from the Station Road works.
