DAVENTRY TRADES COUNCIL

Trades councils date from the 1840s when they were founded in the major urban centres as a means of creating an inter-union organization which functioned at a local level. Out of the trades councils came the Trades Union Congress, the first successful inter-union organization to function at a national level, which first met in 1868. By 1895, the TUC had superceded the trades councils. The two bodies were only to be properly re-united in 1926 and since the early 1940s, the TUC has looked to the trades councils to act as its local counterparts.

Daventry Trades Council was founded in 1964, in view of the planned future expansion of the town as overspill accommodation for the city of Birmingham and in the hope that every trade union branch in the area would affiliate. There was no precedent for a trades council in Daventry and membership fluctuated greatly. Although very involved in the political campaigns of the labour movement (see especially ZB 738/64-69) during the more active periods of its life, the Daventry Trades Council could not survive the retirement from office of its long serving secretary, Roy Sharp (1964-1985). It formally ceased to exist as of its AGM in November 1986, and its papers (entirely consisting of the secretary's files) were deposited in the record office in March 1987.
