#### Introduction

The firm was established in 1864 in domestic premises on the Hackney Road by the grandfather of the last owner, who had previously worked for a trimmings maker in Newgate Street. By 1909 Sindall moved to Middleton Road, Dalston, where a small two storey factory was constructed.

Under the direction of the founder's son, the firm expanded during and after the First World War, and installed several belt driven power looms. Initially after he death of the founder, George Sindall, in February 1914 the business was bintly run by Albert Alexander Sindall and Harold Francis Sindall, who entered into artnership in that year. However disagreement arose between the brothers and the artnership was dissolved. Albert Sindall carried on the business alone until his eath in 1929, when his son A.Sindall took over.

The business remained at Albert Road (renamed Middleton Road, so that the later address was 116-118 Middleton Road) and during the later 1920s and 1930s Sindall's was the largest manufacturer of trimmings in London, employing about fifty people. They maintained a steady output until the late 1960s and 1970s when cheaper imported goods from India and Pakistan entered the market and this together with changes in fashion in items like dressing gowns resulted in a fall in demand.

In 1976 Mr Sindall sold the business to a Nottingham manufacturer specialising harge scale production of braids and trimmings. The firm finally closed bwn in 1981 and most of the machinery and stock moved to Nottingham.

#### coss references

Sindall's were approached by the Museum of London in 1980-81 and acquired a collection of machines and equipment used by the firm, together with some of the records. These are listed here in an additional section to the main list. They also made photographic records and produced a report (from which this introduction has taken information). A copy of the report is in the local history book collection. Selected photographs are in the visual collection. Hackney Archives Department made an oral history tape with Mr Sindall, which may be consulted on request. A video film of the premises was made by the Greater London Industrial Archaeological Society (1994 At H.A.O.)
