EALING: Diaries of Ernest John Chandler of Ealing, for the years
1941, 1944-1951

(E. J. C. was born at Market Bosworth, Leicestershire in 1870. He was educated at the local grammar school. At the age of 16 he was apprenticed to Stagg and Mantle, drapers of Leicester Square, London. He married Ada Fanny Dyer (1874-1972) of Hailey, Oxon, and had issue:

Robert Storer 1899-

Ernest Tom Carvell 1900-

John Eustace 1901-1929 (killed in accident)

Winifred Ada, M.B.E. 1905-1979

Douglas Oliver 1907-

Ralph 1910-1929 (killed in accident)

Gerald Miller 1924-1975

He left Stagg and Mantle as a director in 1929 when the business sold out to the Drapery Trust, part of the Hatry group.

He was a prominent Mason. He lived at 33 Clovelly Road, Ealing, from about 1904 until his death in 1954).
