## NOTES

Ranby House School was founded in 1948, but it was not the only preparatory school for Worksop College at that time. Since 1912, or even some years earlier, Worksop had had its own preparatory department, and this did not close until 1953. Immediately after 1948 we see regular reports on both Ranby and the Worksop prep. in the Worksopian. This unusual overlap makes it clear that Ranby was never a College prep. school re-housed, but a separate entity from the first.

With the issue of the first 'Ranbian' in 1955 the events of Ranby life are well chronicled, and although other records are patchy it should be possible to extend them by seeking the reminiscences of Old Ranbians. In any case, sections D and E of this list provide a useful foundation on which to build. Reports of Her Majesty's Inspectors and the descriptive papers to which their visits give rise are always important to a school archive, and E 2, 7 & 8 bear this out. Those who wish to know what Ranbians thought and felt will be no less interested in the unofficial magazines and boys' essays under E 4. It was the boys then and the boys and girls now who provide the true reflection of a lively school.
