

#### NOTES ON THE ABBOTS BROMLEY ARCHIVE

The Abbots Bromley schools are fortunate in the published works which cover their early years, but less happy in the amount of early source material to hand. The accounts given in the books by Miss Macpherson and Miss Rice have authority, and yet the few letters which survive from girls and teachers (A II 5, A III 3 A III 4, A II 16, etc) suggest that there is more to add to make the rounded picture. Perhaps Old Girls and their descendants may yet supply this need.

As in all the older Woodard schools there is a good collection of letters from the main figures of the society, with the Founder, Provost Lowe and others well represented. The architect, Richard Carpenter, whose work is prominent at the school, is seen in regular correspondence with the Provost, and the early struggles to raise money, to secure clean water supplies and good drains and to build and build are well in line with the Woodard story.

The main importance of the Abbots Bromley archive lies in the light it sheds upon the development of the education of women and the part played in that advance by some outstanding individuals. The documents point to many significant figures, not least Miss Coleridge, Miss Gamlen, Miss Rice and Miss Roch. The private notebook of Miss Rice (A III 7) survives, probably from the earliest years of this century, and in it she makes clear her objectives and her methods at S. Annes. From just before her time we have the timetable for a form of fifteen Year old girls in 1899 ( K 1), which is of great interest and serves to set the scene into which Miss Rice came. These are vital papers, but there are many more to fill out the picture of an important girls' school in the making and in full growth. B 24, B 29, B 30 and B 31 show the organisation at work under five Head Mistresses, whilst through M 14, the uneven but continuous diary of Talbot house, we can see house life as the girls knew it over sixty years.

There is much here of value to the school and the Corporation as well as toall those interested in the advance of women's education. The preservation of these records must be matter of concern.
