Notes on the archive material in the office of the Southern

Division of the Woodard Corporation. 43 Church Rd., Hove.

Divisional records must be mainly administrative and financial, and these are no exception. On the administrative side there is an obvious gap in the Chapter minutes before 1923, i.e. before serial 1. The first minute book of S. Nicolas College is held in the office of the Registrar at No. 1 The Sanctuary, Westminster. It opens with the minutes of meeting in 1852, and that meeting receives a full report on the proceedings of the College from 1847 when S. Mary's Grammar School was opened in a room in the New Shoreham Vicarage. The minutes of meetings are continued to 1923, and, together with the books of Chapter minutes in this list, they provide a full series of proceedings from the first Woodard foundation to the present day.

Serial 30 will be of particular interest to Woodard historians. The struggle at Lancing at the turn of the century was dramatic, but also of great importance to the history of the Society in that it involved the fundamental alteration of the Founder's intention to give powers to resident Provosts and Chaplains in the schools which must overbear the powers of the Headmaster.
